COVID-19 Safety Precautions:

Your safety is paramount. This meeting is being held outdoors and under a shade shelter, in order to provide a safe setting. To further ensure attendees' safety, we require all those attending the public meeting in person adhere to the following:

1. Bring and wear a suitable face mask at all times
2. Chairs for attendees will be spaced at least 6 feet apart.
We ask that you maintain social distancing of at least six feet between yourself and other people throughout the meeting, including arrival and departure.
3. Please stay home and monitor your health if you have had close contact with a person who has symptoms of COVID-19 within the past 14 days. Symptoms of COVID-19 may include the following:
 - Fever or chills
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Fatigue
 - Muscle or body aches
 - Headache
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Sore throat
 - Congestion or runny nose
 - Nausea or vomiting
 - Diarrhea
