Background and Alternatives Explored:

TLI's work under the previous agreement was only for the design phase of the project, which included services such as preliminary project assessment, planning, and design; field work and surveying; and Department of Environmental Quality approvals and submittals.

The contract amendment will extend TLI's services through the remainder of the project including such services as bidding, construction administration, staking, testing, and project closeout.

Construction on this project will involve replacing approximately 1,700 lineal feet of 6-inch kalamain pipe installed in 1914 that has experienced a number of leaks in the past and is believed to be leaking currently. This segment of 3rd Street is also a priority for street repairs by the Street Maintenance Division.

Financial Implications:

Costs will be paid from the Water Fund.
