Background and Alternatives Explored:
Missoula Water proposes to hire IMEG Corp. to provide design and construction administration services for the installation of a Pressure Reducing Vault (PRV) and approximately ½ block of existing Kalmein water main adjacent to the proposed PRV. This PRV would provide a redundant water feed to a large section of the lower Rattlesnake and provide increased flow rates at fire hydrants in this area.
