I move the City Council: To adopt or deny a resolution declaring the official intent of the City of Missoula, Montana, to reimburse certain original expenditures related to sidewalk, curb, gutter and alley approach improvements from the proceeds of the tax-exempt bonds to be issued by the City after the payment of such original expenditures.

Background and Alternatives Explored:

Pursuant IRS regulations a municipality must adopt a statement of official intent to reimburse an original expenditure with tax exempt debt. This reimbursement resolution enables the City to issue tax exempt debt in the future should it be deemed economically advantageous to do so to fund capital projects.

Financial Implications:

The City has a reasonable expectation that it will issue one or more series of tax-exempt bonds (the "Bonds") in the estimated maximum principal amount of \$450,000 to finance the Projects and that the City will make reimbursement allocations with respect to such original expenditures for the Projects from the proceeds of such Bonds.
