> Previous Community Service: I served as a member of the BPAB during 2017 through most of 2019; serving as Chair in 2019. When I was scheduled for major surgery in October, I decided to resign from the board; not knowing how long my recovery would be and not wanting to make it more difficult for the board to make a quorum at meetings. As of January I am fully recovered and looking forward to the possibility of rejoining the BPAB.

> Interest in serving on the board:

As before, I am interested in promoting an improving situation in my community for those who walk and bike — physically, educationally and culturally. This has been an interest of mine for many years.

> Special Knowledge, Experience:

I have been a utilitarian (commuting) and recreational (touring/fitness) bicyclist for the past 5 decades. In my previous residence (Kona, HI) I consulted with state Highway Planners; resulting in them accepting and establishing a revised bicycle lane configuration to reduce potential conflict zones in a stretch of 4 lane highway passing near town. I keep in touch, by way of social media, with various nationally known people and organizations involved with bicycling infrastructure and education as well as urban planning for sustainable transportation.
