Background and Alternatives Explored:

Pursuant IRS regulations a municipality must adopt a statement of official intent to reimburse an original expenditure with tax exempt debt. This reimbursement resolution enables the City to issue tax exempt debt in the future should it be deemed economically advantageous to do so to fund capital projects.

Financial Implications:

The City has a reasonable expectation that it will issue one or more series of tax-exempt bonds (the "Bonds") in the estimated maximum principal amount of \$2,200,000 to finance the Bridge Apartments purchase and that the City will make reimbursement allocations with respect to such original expenditures for the Bridge Apartments from the proceeds of such Bonds.
