Background and Alternatives Explored:

Morrison Maierle is representing the owner of lot 4, Forty-Four Ranch Estates, Steven Bleecker. The owner Steven Bleecker is requesting the City vacate a 30 feet wide public roadway easement and a 60 feet wide public utility easement. The purpose of the public roadway easement and the public utility easement was for the future extension of Roundup Drive. Roundup Drive will not be extended because of the construction of nearby Chuck Wagon Drive. The reason this public roadway easement and public utility easement are being vacated is the property owner is planning on constructing a garage over the easements. The public utility easement has no utilities in it and all utility companies have signed the easement releases.
