Background and Alternatives Explored:
On August 30th, 2021, Missoula City Council approved a construction contract with Prospect Construction for the Caras Outfall Storm Water Infiltration & Caras Park Phase 1, for which the City agreed to pay an amount not to exceed \$2,162,591.65

Part of the project included “owner provided” park and trail lights. Three approved equal lights were quoted with the Mountain States Lights providing the best value (see attached).

Financial Implications:
The contract cost \$39,276.00 and is part of an approved CIP for FY22 funding through Park District and Private funds from the Missoula Downtown Partnership.
