**Background and Alternatives Explored:**

This interlocal agreement between the City of Missoula and Missoula County is the next step in the acquisition of the Missoula Federal Building. The agreement codifies how the two entities can collaboratively oversee design and, later, construction. On February 22, 2022, the Board of County Commissioners will consider the same Interlocal. If the Interlocal is approved, staff will complete contracting with A&E Design to commence design. Due diligence on the project has been completed, and the City and County expect to receive title to the building in autumn of 2022.
