Background and Alternatives Explored:

The items on the resolution have served their useful life for the City of Missoula's purposes and needs and are no longer being used or operated by the City or have become too costly to operate and maintain. This resolution requires a 2/3 vote of all city council members to pass.

Financial Implications:

Items determined to have value will be sold at auction, go out to bid, sold or traded to any county or political subdivision (MCA 7-8-101), or donated. Any items that cannot be sold at auction, purchased through the bid process, sold or traded to any county or political subdivision or donated will be sold for scrap or salvage value. Any items that have no scrap or salvage value will be disposed of properly and in compliance with EPA standards. All proceeds from the sale of surplus properties will be returned to the Missoula Fire Department's special revenue account.
