**Background and Alternatives Explored:**

The City purchased Hybrid Energy Group in 2020 which was contract operating the poplar farm. The Wastewater Division is now directly managing the operation. The expertise, equipment and labor of Sprinkler Maniac is still required to operate and maintain the irrigation system.

**Financial Implications:**

\$108,675.00 from the Wastewater Enterprise Fund
