Background and Alternatives Explored:

Partnership Health Center (PHC), with the assistance of the City of Missoula, is committed to achieving our mission of promoting optimal health and well-being for all, through comprehensive, patient focused, accessible and equitable care. PHC's medical, dental and behavioral health providers work tirelessly to support this mission and provide the highest standard of care to everyone in our community – especially children, adults, families and seniors with limited financial and health resources.

Partnership Health Center (PHC) respectfully requests a re-budgeting of \$35,000, originally slated for PHC's COVID-19 vaccination campaign, to support PHC's pediatric health efforts. When this funding was originally requested, COVID-19 vaccinations had recently become available and we expected to need additional resources to fund a substantial vaccination effort. Not long after submitting for city of Missoula funds, PHC qualified for, and received, a large amount of federal funding targeted at COVID vaccinations. Because of this, we feel that the CBO funding would be better used for other programs, specifically childcare and pediatric health.
