Approve the Professional Services Agreement Amendment No. 2 with Morrison-Maierle

I move the City Council: Approve and Authorize the Mayor to sign a Professional Services Amendment No. 2 with Morrison-Maierle for the Lincoln Hills Upper and Lower Tank Replacement Project at a cost not to exceed \$11,699.00.

**Background and Alternatives Explored:**

The original bid amounts for the Upper Lincoln Hills and Lower Lincoln Hills Tanks exceeded budget amounts and engineer statements of probable construction costs. So the City of Missoula requested that alternative tank construction methods be explored. Contract Amendment No. 1 provided for redesign, and rebid efforts and removed the 3rd party geotechnical testing requirement from the construction administration task. Now that the final tank configuration is known and the project has been awarded to a contractor, geotechnical testing is necessary to be added into the project for quality assurance review.
