Action Required:

Formally adopt the Memorandum of Understanding between the City and All Nations Health Center for partnership in designing a services and staffing model for the Trinity Navigation Center.

Recommended Motion(s):

I move the City Council:

To formally adopt the Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Missoula and All Nations Health Center for partnership in designing a services and staffing model for the Trinity Navigation Center and accompanying project design elements as outlined in the agreement.

Background and Alternatives Explored:

The City released a formal Request for Information (RFI) in February 2022 seeking partners interested in providing services and staffing at the Trinity Navigation Center. Prior to the release of the RFI, City staff worked in partnership with consultants at Corporation for Supportive Housing on a community design process to understand needs and goals for the new Navigation Center. This included conversations with local elected leaders and community partners and stakeholders, including a large community co-design visioning session in Fall 2021.

The RFI yielded two responses. All Nations Health Center demonstrated a clear vision for services at the Navigation Center and a strategic approach to staffing, funding, and various other key components outlined in the RFI. City staff have been in regular conversation with All Nations since March and are supportive of the model that All Nations proposes for housing services at the Navigation Center.
