Housing Montana Heroes

- Currently on site at the Poverello Center
- Supports 20 Veterans
- VA asking for transition to non-congregate setting
- VA support = \$1 million

Property Acquisition

- Clark Fork Inn
- Poverello Center purchased in Dec. 2021
 - Bridge loan from the Otto Bremer Trust
- 17 tenants will need to be relocated
- Renovation + construction = 20 units

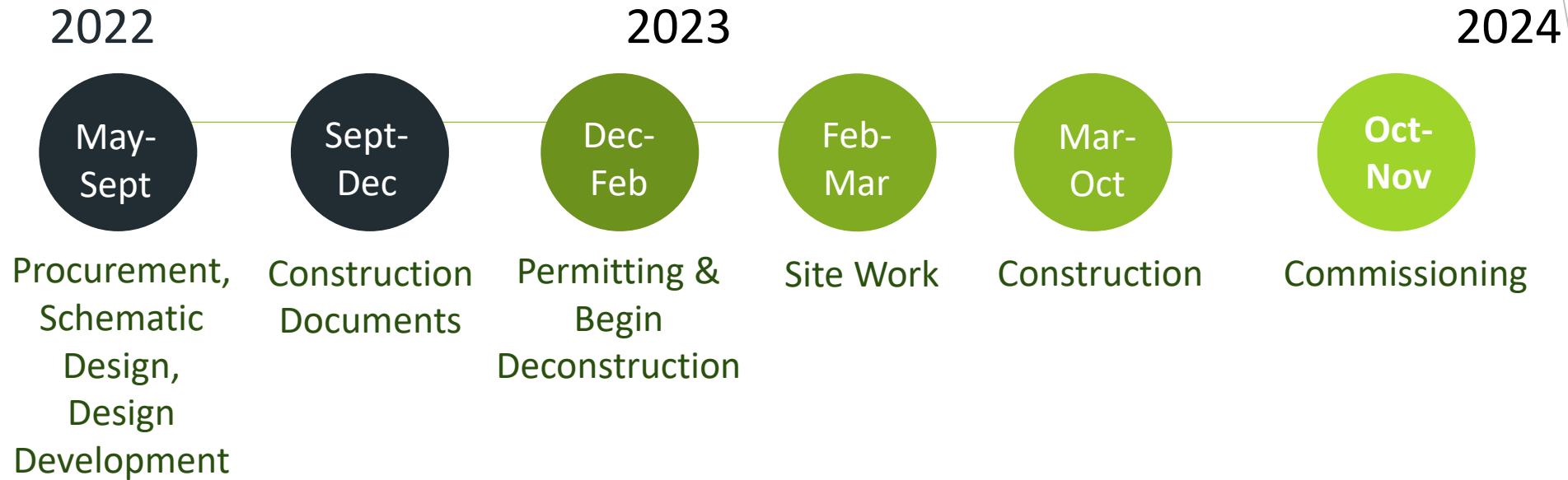
- \$1 million VA

- Labor, environmental, procurement, Uniform Relocation Assistance (URA)
- Most restrictive guidelines rule for the entire project
