I move the City Council: approve and authorize the Mayor to sign an agreement with Watershed Consulting LLC. for the amount of \$45,500.00 for forest thinning on Mt. Jumbo and in Marshall Canyon.

Background and Alternatives Explored: This project is the continued implementation of forest health management and restoration work as identified in the 2014 Mount Jumbo Forest Management Plan on Critical Elk Winter Range. The cost for professional services to thin the forest unit in Marshall Canyon (\$21,000.00) is paid for through a grant from the MT DNRC, while the cost to thin the unit on Mount Jumbo (\$24,500.00) is paid for out of the 2018 Conservation Stewardship Mill Levy. A Request for Proposals was advertised in the Missoulian and on the City's website. Following a competitive process thinning units were awarded to two separate contractors, based on cost, experience, timelines and project approach. Watershed Consulting LLC received 2 of the 4 units advertised.

Financial Implications: In-kind match for the DNRC grant has already been met, and there is no match required for work on the Mt. Jumbo unit.
