- WHEREAS, James K. Caras immigrated from Greece to the United States in 1908 and chose to make Missoula, Montana, his home; and
- WHEREAS, James K. Caras applied hard work and dedication to the conduct of his business and became a successful partner in the local business industry and generously contributed his time, energy and resources to the betterment of the Missoula community; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Missoula Park Board voted in 1977 to re-name Island Park in Missoula as "Caras Park" in honor of James K. Caras; and
- **WHEREAS**, the history of James K. Caras' contributions to the community was not widely known, which prompted a group of Missoula citizens to cause to be prepared a bronze plaque summarizing his life to be placed in Caras Park; and
- **WHEREAS**, on May 10, 2022, the Missoula Parks and Recreation Board voted to permit the placement of this plaque and, further, voted to re-dedicate Caras Park to honor James K. Caras,
