Approve a service agreement with 2G Energy for maintenance on the Co-Gen for FY 2023.

Background and Alternatives Explored:

The Missoula Resource Recovery Facility operates a biogas combined heat and power (CHP) generator. This generator creates 25% of the electricity required to operate the facility. The non-fossil fuel bio-gas is produced onsite through anaerobic digestion. This maintenance agreement is necessary for the CHP operation. The City has a sole source designation with 2G Energy.
