PROCLAMATION

- **WHEREAS**, September 17, 2022 marks the two hundred and thirty-fifth anniversary of the framing of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and
- **WHEREAS**, it is fitting and proper to give official recognition to this document and its memorable anniversary and to the patriotic celebrations which will commemorate it; and
- **WHEREAS**, Public Law 915 guarantees the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America, designating September 17 through 23 as Constitution Week.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Gwen Jones, Acting Mayor of the City of Missoula, in the State of Montana, hereby recognize the

17th day of September as Constitution Day; and the 17th of September through the 23rd of September as Constitution Week,

and urge all citizens to study the Constitution, and to reflect on the privilege of being an American, with all of the rights and responsibilities which that privilege involves.
