Background and Alternatives Explored:

Public Works & Mobility is proposing to enter into a Professional Services Agreement with Morrison-Maierle to design improvements to Kelly Island Lift Station. Kelly Island lift station, originally constructed in 2004, requires improvements to meet current and future inflow rates. Kelly Island Lift Station serves the rapidly developing Mullen BUILD area and peak flow rates are expected to increase by approximately 37%. Lift station improvements are required to provide adequate pump capacity, wet well storage volume, provide operational redundancy, and optimize pump run times.

Financial Implications: This project will be funded by a Clean Water SRF loan.
