Background and Alternatives Explored:
In February 2021, a Memorandum of Agreement was established between the City, Montana Fish Wildlife & Parks (FWP), and Trout Unlimited in regard to removing or rehabilitating the dams on the mountain lakes and restoring Rattlesnake Creek. The City and Trout Unlimited worked collaboratively to secure funding from the Montana Renewable Resource Project Grant through the Montana Department of Natural Resources and Conservation.

Trout Unlimited will be the contractor for the project and perform the scope of work stated in Attachment A of the Sub-Recipient Agreement.
