Background and Alternatives Explored:

This summer the City released a RFP for a security vendor to provide services across Operation Shelter sites. City staff reached out to 5 vendors and received 4 proposal responses. A review committee made up of City and County staff and leadership reviewed the 4 proposals and will present a proposed model for services through fiscal year 2023.

Financial Implications:

Funding for Operation Shelter security services will come from American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds and was approved as part of the Operation Shelter budget item in the FY23 budget cycle.
