Background and Alternatives Explored:

The Union Place Apartments LLC is applying for Low Income Housing Tax Credits to preserve and rehabilitate 63 units at Union Place Apartments. Currently the apartments are available to households earning at or below 60 percent of Area Median Income. The tax credit award would protect the affordability of this property for an additional 46 years. The Union Place Apartments LLC is applying for 4 percent tax credit to invest in rehabilitation. The Qualified Allocation Plan (QAP) which governs the allocation process for Montana Housing Credits requires applicants to hold a public hearing in partnership with local government to share plans and hear public comment.
