I believe \$10,000 was to be set aside with the sell of each lot to help fund said bridge. It appears these developers wiggled out of this agreement leaving the Missoula county tax payers to pick up the tab of the infrastructure improvements necessary for their plans. I suspect they will be again proposing widening Lower Miler creek to possibly a 4 lane. I may be old school but feel the developers should install infrastructure on THEIR dime BEFORE they build, not the inverse..
