## **Background and Alternatives Explored:**

In 2021, the Montana Legislature passed H.B. 407, which placed a statewide "ban on bans. This is a non-binding resolution which declares Missoula's support for legislation during the 2023 Legislative session that would restore power to local governments to regulate single use plastics. This resolution aligns with the City of Missoula climate and suitability goals.
