Background and Alternatives Explored:

In 1996, the City of Missoula and Missoula County entered an interlocal agreement establishing the provision of land use planning services, transportation planning services and grants administration under an Office of Planning and Grants. This agreement has been modified many times over the course of the last 20 years, including significant modifications to the organizational and financial structure of the Office of Planning and Grants. The last modifications were approved in 2013. The proposed changes before you will serve as our next update.

The purpose of this Agreement, as originated in 1996 and as modified before you today, is to enhance the ability of the City and County to plan for future development so that a countywide pattern of development, land use, and conservation is created that reflects the environmental, economic, aesthetic, and social values of city and county residents.
