Approve renewal of Stop Loss Insurance for new claim period of calendar year 2021.

I move the City Council: Approve and authorize the Mayor to sign the renewal of Stop Loss Insurance provided by VOYA for Option 1 large claim health plan coverage effective January 1 through December 31, 2021 for an estimated monthly charge of \$73,504.00

Background and Alternatives Explored:

The City's claim administrator, Allegiance Benefit Plan Management, Inc., solicited bids and provided options for consideration. Option 1 provides the same specs/service/coverage as the current plan and is recommended for the new plan period of calendar year 2021.

Financial Implications:

Stop loss insurance covers all costs over \$160K but doesn't start until the City has absorbed the first \$60K (regardless of whether the \$60K is one large claim or several smaller claims). Option 1 represents continuing coverage without change. The cost of Option 1, estimated at \$73,504 monthly or \$882,043 annually, represents an increase of 3% over previous annual coverage charges.
