Approve the construction agreement with Western Interstate for the deconstruction of the Wooden Images building.

Background and Alternatives Explored:

Missoula Water acquired the Wooden Images building at 1359 West Broadway in February 2021. The building was used for storage but the roof began leaking during the winter of 2021/2022. Missoula Water believes the building is inhabitable and will create a potential public safety risk if the roof is not repaired. The Missoula Fire Department investigated potential options for using the building to house its Mobile Support Team but determined that it was infeasible. The building requires abatement of asbestos and lead paint prior to being deconstructed. Missoula Water solicited multiple bids for the abatement work as well as the deconstruction work. Abatement Contractors of Montana was the low bidder for the abatement work and Western Interstate was the low bidder for the deconstruction work. The abatement contract will be a separate referral. The cost of deconstruction will be split between Missoula Public Works Utilities and Road District and the Missoula Redevelopment Agency. The property is intended to be integrated into future redevelopment plans for the Missoula Water property at 1345 West Broadway.

Financial Implications:

The deconstruction cost will be split as follows: Missoula Redevelopment Agency: \$60,722

Missoula Water: \$9,613

Road District #1 Engineering: \$1,680 Missoula Stormwater Utility: \$1,540 Road District #1 Administration: \$1,260
