Background and Alternatives Explored: On October 18th, a community member representative who was a voting member of the Affordable Housing Resident Oversight Committee resigned. Heidi West, Emily Harris-Shears, Housing Policy Specialist, and Aubrey Godbey Housing Programs Coordinator and committee staff all support the promotion of Emily Shankle, community member, who has been serving as an Alternate member since 02/2022 and who is interested in becoming a voting member. The promotion of Emily creates a vacant alternate position and Heidi West, Emily Harris-Shears and Aubrey Godbey all support appointing Colin Lane as the new alternate. Colin Lane interviewed on 10/12/2022 to be a voting member and is interested in being appointed as an alternate. City Council rules #32 states that Council can consider applicants that have been interviewed in the past 12 months.
