Short Title: Neighborhood Traffic Management Plan, Quick-Build
Please describe the request and community benefit
The quick-build program is seeing success in Missoula by creating safer transportation for pedestrians, cyclists, and car drivers alike. This is a cost-effective program that is currently being used to build traffic circles at unmarked intersections, bulb outs to make for safer crossings, and other traffic calming measures. Out of the 24 projects built so far, staff has found a 5-30% speed reduction at these spots as well as a 25-60% volume reduction. While Missoula has many unmarked intersections and dangerously designed intersections and crossings, it is important that we take steps to quickly minimize the danger of these spots. The community benefit is that this program leads to less crashes, less severity in crashes, and overall helps all Missoulians get around town safely.
