

## City Council Proposed Budget Changes Form Fiscal Year 2024 **Council member name:** Daniel Carlino Herbicide Free, McCormick Pilot Program Short Title: Please describe the request and community benefit Developed Parks and Trails, in joint efforts and with support from community members and local nonprofit organizations such as Grow Safe Missoula and Healthy Babies Bright Futures (HBBF), Bright Cities, are striving to build a natural and organic, herbicide free approach to manage turf in our parks and the community. With grant funding from HBBF Parks & Rec. were able to acquire services of nonprofits Osborne Organics and Beyond Pesticides to provide training, consultation, and recommendations for moving toward managing healthier turf naturally and organically. A recently purchased and ordered nutrient tank sprayer/granular spreader will allow for application of products needed for this program, however, the labor and supplies/materials are needed to fully implement these methods. 2 month season extention of a Maintenance Worker, from 7.25 months to 9.25 months, benefits, insurance (as this will make a current employee eligible for full Insurance, supplies for employee, supplies to implement program). Funding this extension will ensure we stay on track with the herbicide free pilot program and will help us move faster towards eliminating herbicides from our parks and trails system.
