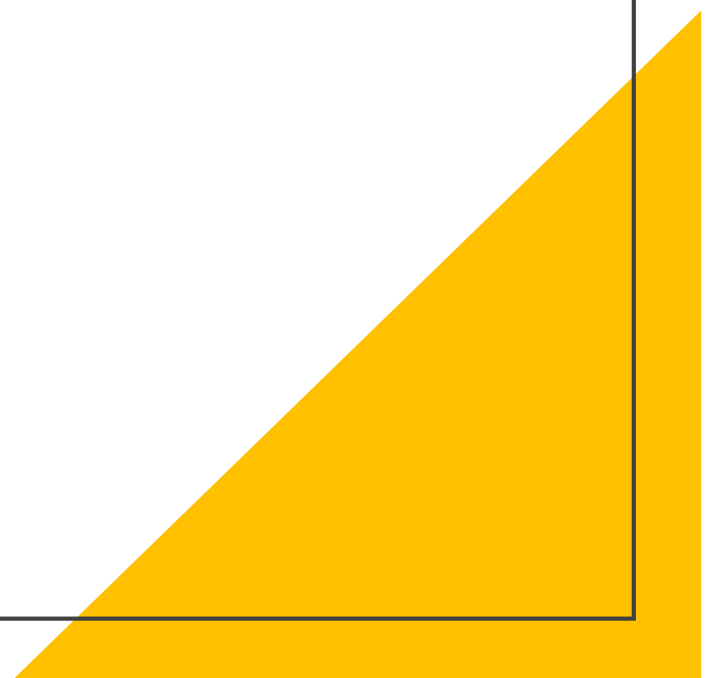

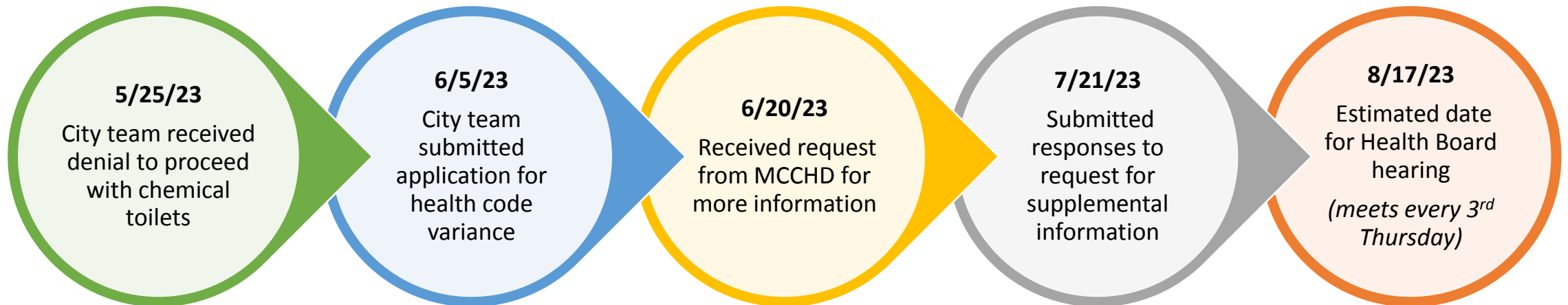


Background & Timeline



Health Code Variance

- Required in order to continue short-term use of chemical toilets for the shelter
- Chemical toilets are insufficient for year-round use of the facility, prompting plans for renovation and construction
- Variance would allow the shelter to re-open while construction is underway, as opposed to waiting until winter when construction is complete
- City team working closely with Poverello Center staff and others on the application



Renovation and Construction

Exploring two viable solutions:

Bathroom Trailers

- Purchasing bathroom trailers that can hookup directly to sewer and water

New Building Structure

- Building a new structure on the property and adding bathrooms and showers inside that structure

**Note: renovating the current building to add bathrooms inside the facility has been eliminated as an option due to significant costs associated with that approach*
