- **WHEREAS**, the League has consistently been noted for its nonpartisan election information, including sponsorship of candidate forums and information on state and local ballot issues, as well as its commitment to register, educate, and mobilize voters; and
- **WHEREAS**, the League champions government systems that are open, transparent, inclusive, and equitable, including the 1972 Montana Constitution; and
- **WHEREAS**, the League believes that active, informed, and engaged citizens, irrespective of gender, ethnicity, or political affiliation, are the hallmark of democracy.
