Dear Adam,

To summarize, the bids for the City of Missoula WWTP RAS Valve Replacement Procurement were due electronically via the QuestCDN bidding site on January 29th, at 2:00 P.M. (local MST time). The bids were opened electronically by Adam Marsh, P.E., City of Missoula Utility Engineer. There were two (2) electronic bids submitted, from Northwest Pipe Fittings and Core and Main. The electronic bids were reviewed and considered responsive and accepted by the City. Northwest Pipe Fittings had to resubmit the BABA Manufacturer Certificate on bid day as it did not upload.

Jacobs has reviewed the submitted bids for accuracy and completeness, included bidding forms and requirements and bid price. A review of the Bid Form was also conducted and deemed acceptable. All bidders acknowledged the two (2) addenda, read the Instruction to Bidders, submitted the Bid Bond, and completed and uploaded to QuestCDN the Information Required of Bidders, Bid Form, BABA Certifications, Certification Regarding Debarment, Suspension, and Other Responsibility Matters, Certification of Non-Segregated Facilities, and Non-Collusion Affidavit. This bid only consisted of a Base Bid lump sum bid item.

It should be noted that project milestones for valve delivery as specified in the contract bidding documents cannot be met by either bidder. Valve lead times submitted by Northwest Pipe Fittings are estimated to be 38 weeks for plug valves and 45 weeks for check valves. Valve lead time estimates from Core and Main are 50 weeks for plug valves and 46 weeks for check valves. The low bidder, Northwest Pipe Fittings, had the lowest lead times and both bidders bid DeZurik valves. These lead time estimates are from submittal approval. Given the lead times, the agreement form will need to be modified prior to execution to reflect realistic project milestones.

After thorough review, it has been determined that **Northwest Pipe Fittings** is the apparent lowest responsive bidder for the base bid. Please see the attached Certified Bid Tabulation summarizing both submitted bids. After discussion with the City, we recommend award to the lowest responsive bidder, **Northwest Pipe Fittings** for the Base Bid at a cost of **\$186,992.00** for the above-mentioned project.

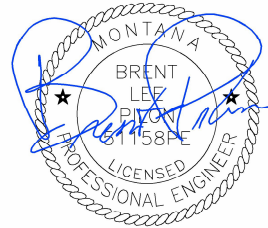

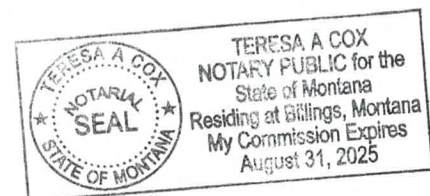

ARTICLE 1 - CONTRACT

1.01 The undersigned Bidder proposes and agrees, if this Bid is accepted, to enter into an Agreement with BUYER in the form included in the Bidding Documents, to furnish Goods and Special Services as specified or indicated in the Bidding Documents for the prices and within the times indicated in this Bid and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents. 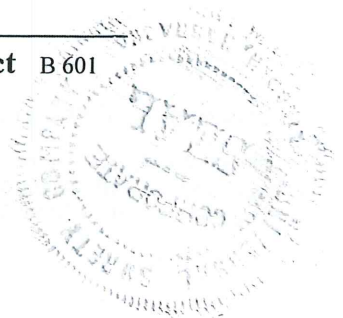

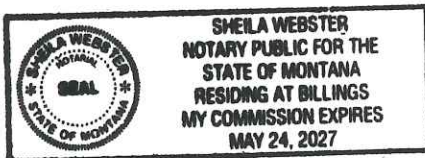

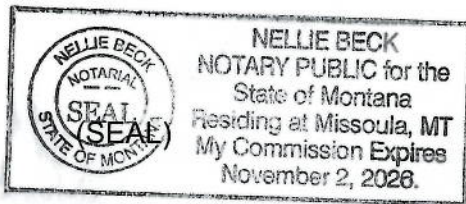
