Her property is next to the proposed tower on Gharrett St. and she would like this email to go on record against the tower. The Rufus Road property is not her primary residence and we live in Trout Creek, MT and it is not possible to attend the meeting on January 5.

She is against the tower because it is high enough to decrease the property values of the surrounding properties. This particular part of Missoula is very scenic and depends on views of the valley floor. A tower 80 feet tall is a significant change to the views all around the area. In addition, the tower will be directly in some neighbors' view. Views are important to property values. Property values are extremely important to everyone in the area and a shorter tower would protect property values. A 30 or 40 foot tower would also have great broadcast capability. A shorter tower needs to be considered.
