**Background and Alternatives Explored:**  
Public Works & Mobility is proposing to amend a Professional Services Agreement with Jacobs Engineering Consultants to replace the mixing system in Digester 2. This amendment is for design of a pump and nozzle mixing system and includes scope for design and bidding services. Digester 2 was constructed in 1961 and enlarged in 1985. Excessive grit buildup was discovered when Digester 2 was taken off-line for cleaning in summer of 2025. Subsequent investigations determined that the existing draft tube mixer, installed in 1985, provides inadequate mixing. A new pump and nozzle style mixing system will provide mixing across the entire digester depth to enhance digester operation and reduce long-term maintenance costs.

**Financial Implications:**  
\$79,619.00 funded from the wastewater utility enterprise fund under the RRF Equipment Replacement budget.
