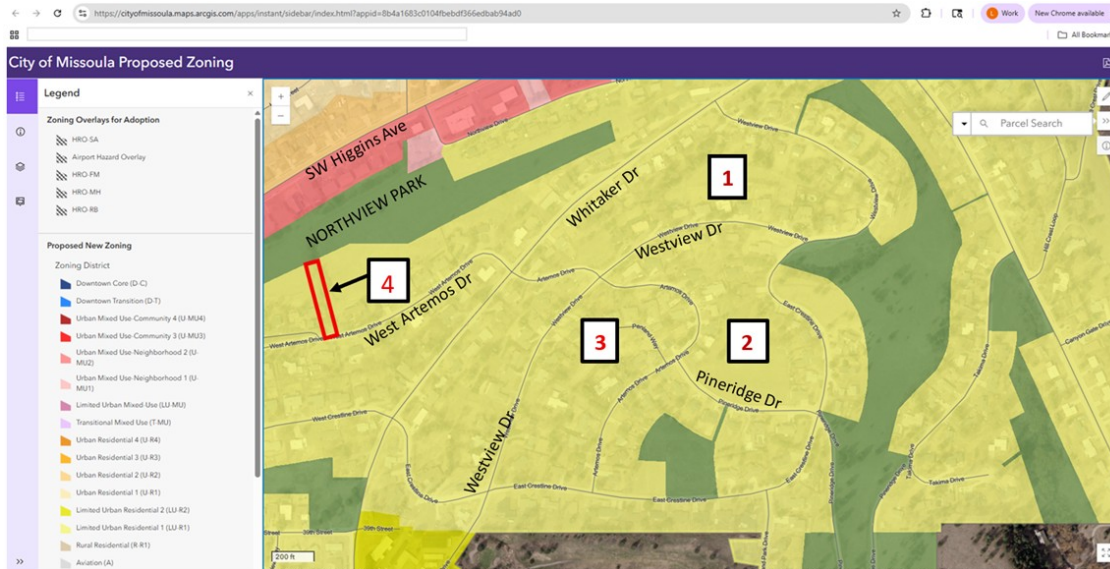

This email is to express my opposition to the proposed LU-R1 zoning of the four (4) city properties described below. My request is these city properties be zoned OP-1 or zoned such that it would support public use of open, outdoor areas which would remain owned by the city of Missoula.
