3.4 Resolution amending fiscal year 2019 budget for Crosby/Cleveland Traffic Calming Circle and KAboom Rose Park Memorial

Scott Paasch, Finance Dept, presented the agenda item. Julie Merritt asked for history on the Rose Park traffic circle. Ben Weiss, Bike Pedestrian Coordinator with Development Services indicated this is project spearheaded by a neighborhood. Neighbors received a Neighborhood Project Fund grant from the City's Office of Neighborhoods and then raised the funds necessary to install the circle. On a field visit, City Engineering Division staff realized there would be a tight turning radius for buses traversing the intersection so the location of the circle was moved and resulted in increased costs. City Engineer

Slovarp noted that the additional expense is being managed through the City Engineering budget.

Michelle Cares asked what is the process and ADA requirements for approving a traffic calming circle.

Kevin Slovarp, City Engineer, explained that sidewalk was on all four corners of this particular intersection.

Michelle Cares stated that was helpful and understanding the parameters is helpful.

Ben Weiss provided additional details.

John DiBari asked where the money for the contribution is coming from. Mr. Slovarp itemized the sources of the monies.

Heidi West asked if a drawing of the final project could be provided.

Gwen Jones explained that neighbors have been working on this for years. She is glad this is finally getting finished and thanked Mr. Slovarp for making it work.

Regarding the KAboom Roard Park project, John DiBari asked where the \$65,000 is coming from. Mr. Paasch indicated the funding would be paid from park impact fees.
