Approve a construction agreement amendment with Knife River, Inc. for additional work on the Railroad Street Water Main Replacement Project.

I move the City Council: Approve and authorize the Mayor to sign an agreement amendment with Knife River, Inc. for water line installation work along McCormick Street from Toole Avenue to West Alder Street as part of the Railroad Street Water Main Replacement Project at a cost not to exceed \$33,143.00.

Background and Alternatives Explored:

It was determined during construction of the other portions of work in the area that it made sense to also complete the water main replacement in McCormick Street from Toole Avenue to West Alder Street. This will eliminate an older 6-inch kalamein water main in McCormick Street and will help work in conjunction with a separate service swap project in West Alder Street that Missoula Water is working on.
