The City conducted a national search for its new CFO. Gannon is a graduate of the University of Montana and most recently served as general manager of King County (Washington) Metro, the transit agency serving the greater Seattle area, where he was responsible for the operation, strategy, planning and financial health of a 5,000-employee organization serving millions of residents. He also served as a member of the cabinet of the King County Executive, Dow Constantine. Gannon's private-sector experience includes leadership positions at Starbucks Corporation and Amazon. In addition, he served in human resources management at the University of Montana and as financial officer for the Office of Provost Royce Engstrom at UM.
