#### **Background and Alternatives Explored:**

John MacDonald was the City's lobbyist for the 2009, 2011, 2015, 2017, and 2019 legislative sessions. He has an excellent working relationship with both City staff and legislators and has advocated diligently and effectively for the City's interests. Private lobbyists were first used in 2007 with Helena-based lobby firms representing city interests since the 2009 Session. Prior to 2007, mayors, council members and key staff members acted as the primary lobbyists representing city interests. The City's political interests during the legislative sessions are often complex and adequate funding is critical to support city interests.
