RESOLUTION -----

A resolution of the Missoula City Council to name the facility (community garden) located within the Montana Rail Link Park “Bitterroot Line Community Garden.”

Whereas, the Park Board of Missoula adopted the *Park Naming Policy*, which provides guidelines for when and how parks and facilities within parks can be renamed;

Whereas, the name meets Park Naming Policy by referencing the railroad theme of the park and the land donors’ with the railroad term “Line.”

Whereas, the Park Naming Policy suggests that a natural feature or landmark be part of the name, “Bitterroot” references the iconic state flower, the Bitterroot River and the name of the bicycle path which runs adjacent to the Park;

Whereas, the community gardeners who are gardening at this location and Garden City Harvest wish to distinguish the garden from the rest of the park to educate the community on how to grow food and garden in a community setting;

Now therefore, be it resolved that the Missoula City Council hereby approves naming the facility within the Montana Rail Link Park the “Bitterroot Line Community Garden.”
