Background and Alternatives Explored:

The Affordable Housing Citizen Oversight Committee is a key function of the Affordable Housing Trust Fund, outlined in the Affordable Housing Trust Fund Ordinance (Ord. 3663). The Oversight Committee is comprised of three ex-officio roles and eight appointed roles. Appointments to the

Oversight Committee will be made by City Council, the Mayor and the County Board of Commissioners. City Council will appoint three voting members and one alternate. The Mayor will appoint two voting members and one alternate and the Missoula Board of County Commissioners will appoint one voting member.

Recruitment for applications was open from January 6, 2021 through February 10, 2021. Applications were received from 44 candidates. Interviews will be conducted by a sub-committee of the Committee of the Whole that was established on February 17, 2021 to conduct interviews and make appointment recommendations to the Council. The subcommittee membership will include Councilmembers Becerra, Merritt and Jones and County Commissioner Slotnick.
