Background and Alternatives Explored:

Eaton Street is classified as a collector street. Also, Eaton is a transit street with several bus stops along this project. This Eaton Street project ranks number 8th out of 90 CIP projects. Eaton has high traffic volumes and its crash history includes serious injuries.

The project includes constructing curb and sidewalk where none exists, constructing curb bulb outs at certain intersections, constructing one sidewalk bridge and constructing culvert extensions at irrigation ditch sidewalk crossings.

Through the Public Works and Mobility SOQ from a couple months ago we selected five consultant firms to complete transportation projects. IMEG was one of these five firms. We selected IMEG from this list because of their previous work on City projects in this area.
